Having been rather concerned about the many rumours going around in connection with Burford Hospital, we went to see Mr. David Perry, District General Manager, Oxfordshire Health Authority, on June 14th.

He kindly spared us a considerable amount of his time and assured us that there is no proposal to close beds at Burford Hospital to make a saving, nor to reduce the Authority's budget for health care in Burford and District.

I am sure you will be relieved to have this re-assurance, which Mr. Perry has since confirmed in a letter to me.

There may well be some changes in the way in-patient services are financed, which are to be discussed with various people concerned (including the Comforts Fund) but the main point is that there is no proposal to close the Hospital nor its beds, nor to reduce the overall budget for Burford and District.
