

THE WYCHWOODS LIBRARY

The Wychwood Library is situated in Milton High Street, and serves the villages in and around the Wychwoods. We have a stock of 5,000 books and issue around 35,000 books a year. This is done during the three days we are open each week, which includes two evenings.

We provide language courses and books on cassette, and large print books for the partially sighted. A reference area also includes magazines and periodicals. Book searches are made using the microfiche and photocopying is provided at 10p a sheet. We maintain a tourist information rack where local events and information can be found about museums, stately homes and other places of interest.

Just recently we have been supplied with new carpeting and look forward to a new coat of paint. The junior section has just received 300 new books; these include picture and non-fiction books to meet the ever increasing demand for school topics research.

New book selections and circulating collections provide an interesting periodic change to the library stock. We also provide a request service for specialist books. There are plans to stock more paperback books in the near future.

We arrange introduction story times for the Primary School and local playgroups, and holiday story times are well attended. Two story times are arranged for the summer school holidays.
