Serving the communities of Ascott-under Wychwood, Leafield, Field Assarts and Fordwells. The Governors of Leafield School invite parents to take advantage of the provision for rising fives, toddlers and parents in school. The opportunities offered will help you to become part of our school community and also to meet other parents and young children.

On Thursdays, at 2.45 p.m., tea and shared reading sessions take place. These are very well attended by parents of pupils and parents with pre-school children (toddlers to rising fives). Pre-school children are encouraged to borrow books from school regularly and there are occasional play sessions.

Children are admitted into school formally at the beginning of the term in which they become five. Staff specialisms in early years education, alongside appropriate resources, mean that there is suitable provision for rising fives. This initiation period is carried out with close consultation with parents. The staff aim for the children to feel secure and confident as soon as possible. This creates the very best foundation for their future learning and has proved to be a most successful introduction to school. You are welcome to join your children for some of these sessions, so that you can gain an insight into the way in which your child is learning.

Do take the opportunity of both introducing your child to school at an early age and becoming part of the community.
