Most children and young people like a break from time to time. Some children with a disability miss out on enjoyable things. You may be able to help by offering short breaks to a child in your home. This could be good for the child, their family and you.

You could be linked with a child or young person of any age. All children have such different personalities and interests. Words like 'learning difficulty' or 'physical disability' may sound confusing and don't tell you anything about the actual child. You would meet the child and their family and get to know each other before a short break would start.

Before you all meet, you would be given information and training from Social Services. We would all decide between us if giving short breaks was right for you. When a child stays, there would be financial and other support from Social Services.

Short breaks could be for a few hours, overnight, for a weekend, or for a week or two. We would all meet together to make sure that everybody was happy with the breaks. You would know that your Precious Time is also precious for a child and their family.
