
# SHIPTON-under-WYCHWOOD NEW VILLAGE HALL



THE Public Meeting held on 30th November 1993 gave overwhelming support to the proposal to build a new hall on the Recreation Field. The Friends of Shipton-under-Wychwood New Village Hall was formed to spearhead the fundraising and planning of the New Village Hall.

A committee of fourteen was formed from members of the existing Parish Hall and elected members.

Two sub-committees have been set up — a technical committee chaired by Geoff Miles has contacted all regular users of the existing hall for their detailed views and requirements — and a fundraising committee chaired by Margaret Hartley which has been planning various events (see overleaf). Please note the dates in your diaries.

An impressive amount of backroom work has been undertaken in the committee meetings. The plans have ben modified in detail from those circulated by the Parish Council, most notably to include a room 7.6m x 6.0m for the exclusive use of the Youth of the village. These plans will shortly be going to the West Oxfordshire District Council.

Current indications are that the cost of the New Hall will be about £300,000. It is hoped that grants from West Oxfordshire District Council, the County Council and the Parish Council, among others, will make a substantial contribution towards the cost. It is hoped that these could contribute half the total needed. About £60,000 has already been promised from local residents.

The grand opening of the FUNdraising events — if the weather is fine —will be a hot air balloon rising from the very spot from which the New Hall itself will rise. A novel raffle will be performed. Hundreds of numbered little parachutes will be dropped from the balloon. The prize winner will be the parachute caught by John Hartley!

Congratulations must go to Ascott-under-Wychwood for completing its beautiful new Village Hall. We are twice the size of Ascott, let's see if we can achieve ours twice as quickly.
