TAKING THE HEADACHE OUT OF HOME MAINTENANCE FOR OLDER AND DISABLED PEOPLE

If you are over 60 or disabled and live in the West Oxfordshire District Council Area, you may be eligible for assistance from a new Anchor Housing Trust Staying Put scheme.

You may want to remain living in your own home but are concerned about getting repairs done. You may need advice on what needs doing, how to find reliable builders who charge a fair price and how to pay for the work. Whatever your problem may be – a leaking gutter, loose roof tiles, doors and windows that are draughty and starting to rot, old electrical wiring, brickwork that needs repointing, dampness, etc., we might be able to help.

You may be disabled (of any age) and require adaptations to your home, such as the installation of a ground floor toilet and shower, stair lift, grab rails, ramps, etc., but you do not know where to start.

We will advise you on eligibility for council renovation grants and **guide you through the application process.** If you are not eligible for these grants we can advise on other sources of finance available. We will then draw up a schedule of works, obtain prices from builders and supervise the work to make sure it is done to your satisfaction.
