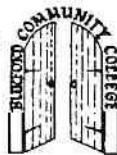




Burford Community College Burford Computer Centre



The Community College has been offering a wide ranging programme of activities to the local community for well over twenty years with a focus on vocational, academic, creative and life enhancing courses for all ages, to which we now recruit over 500 students every Autumn. Most courses run in the evening, with some daytime provision.

The College also does work with the under 5s and older young people; it ensures access to local facilities; offers termly classical concerts; and

provides general educational information and guidance. We also publish a termly newspaper - the "Go-Between" which carries articles of general interest as well as publicity for our programme.

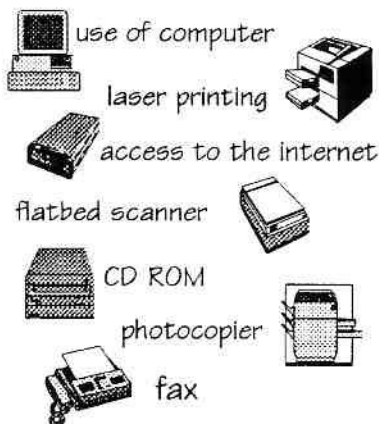
Most of our activities take place on the Burford School site, although we also use Wychwood Primary School and some local village halls. We have recently extended the college block on the Burford school site to include a new computer centre.

The New Computer Centre

Opened in Autumn 94 the centre provides both a large teaching room with 13 powerful computers (486 DX2-66) and 6 printers, equipped with the latest software from Microsoft, Lotus, Wordperfect and Serif and a separate Telecentre with all the facilities of a modern office.

We are therefore now able to offer a wide variety of day, evening and weekend courses to groups of students as well as providing tailor made training for individuals and local businesses. All the facilities of the telecentre are also available for use by the local community.
