

THE LADY READE EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION

This ancient charity was founded almost 100 years ago by Lady Reade of Shipton Court, with the object of providing grants to local young people who had finished formal education, to encourage them to take further education or training towards a career.

It is still in operation and each year applications are invited from young people resident in the "ancient parish of Shipton-under-Wychwood" (which comprises Shipton, Milton, Leafield and Ramsden), and who are undertaking further education at college, university or other approved training situations. Small grants are made, usually up to £20, according to the number of applicants.
