

## BURFORD HOSPITAL

I would like to draw your attention to the work that Burford Hospital Comforts and Amenities Fund does for Burford Hospital and so for the community at large.

The A.G.M. was held recently and published the amount of money the Fund spent last year to help keep the hospital open. £14,200 went on two beds for respite care; £3,484 for extra physiotherapy sessions; £1,534 for extra occupational therapy; £4,276 for assistance towards the salary of the hospital cook and over £3,000 for other improvements and amenities.

In addition to this we are committed to spending £146,000 towards the total cost of £169,000 for the proposed extension to the Day Unit at the hospital. This unit is essential now that more people are being cared for at home, since they also need the therapy and care that Burford Hospital can provide.

We are most grateful to all who contribute to the Comforts Fund – your continued support is vital. We hope too, that others will want to support the Fund in the year to come.
