## POLICE NOTEBOOK

ARE PATROL OFFICERS becoming an endangered species? Have cash cuts made patrolling an afterthought, and do Chief Constables give enough priority to their officers walking the beat?

There is a growing public awareness of the widening gap between resources and demand for police services. Some forces have made basic changes in the style of patrolling to improve efficiency and effectiveness, and although some of these changes have been beneficial, others have been cost driven and have harmed quality of service. To change direction would require an increase in resources, more police officers would be needed to make patrolling fully effective, and given a higher priority.

The number of police currently available for patrol at any one time represents a small fraction of the whole strength. However if patrolling was made the first priority rather than the last, this number could be doubled making a substantial increase.

What price do you put on the high level of reassurance the public have when they see a uniformed police officer on patrol? I believe the value of the beat bobby is immeasurable.



The public tell me they want to see more police in their area. They do not want cheap-jack alternatives. They want real, fully trained, professional police officers.
