MONDAY TO FRIDAY TAXI BUS SERVICE TO WITNEY

The Oxfordshire Rural Community Council (ORCC) has been discussing with Mr Richard Bridgewater of Excel Cars in Minster Lovell, the possibility of starting an early morning (journey to work) taxi-bus run to Witney starting from Milton-under-Wychwood at about 7.20 am and calling at Shipton-u-Wychwood, Ascott-u-Wychwood, Leafield, Crawley and Finstock before making its way to Witney, arriving there soon after 8 am. And a return journey in the afternoon-early evening.

He is proposing to provide this service with a wheelchair-accessible seven-seater vehicle that he could upgrade, or provide a back up if the number of passengers should exceed capacity.

Are there any people who might be interested in using this type of service?

Mr Bridgewater is quite prepared to offer a flexible service such as dropping passengers at their place of work or collecting them on the way back. He would like to start this service as soon as possible and would need the support of the parishes to make it work.

He is offering this journey for a £2 fare each way. Have you got any suggestion to the timings that he is offering? He might be able to offer the same journey at a later time of the day.
