

## THE WYCHWOODS LIBRARY

Oxfordshire County Council Department of Leisure and Arts has indicated its desire to sell the site of the present Wychwoods Library in Milton High Street and has asked the Friends to put forward alternative sites for the relocation of the library.

In the view of the Friends, resiting the library within the grounds of Milton Village Hall is the most attractive proposal since it would maintain the library's position as a focal point in the village and car parking would be available.

A meeting took place recently at which representatives of the Friends submitted their proposals to the Trustees of the Village Hall. The matter is now being considered by the Trustees and it is hoped that their decision will be reached shortly.

The matter has been referred to the Charities Commission for its views concerning the legal implications of such a proposal.
