

## What are minor injuries?

- minor bumps to the head
- sprains and broken bones
- burns, cuts and bruises
- simple ear, nose and eye complaints such as removal of splinters and other foreign bodies.

After initial treatment some people may be referred to specialist services such as the eye hospital.

- problems like difficulty breathing, chest pains and tummy ache
- suspected heart attack / stroke
