

## THE LAWRENCE HOME NURSING TEAM

Dr Martin Lawrence was the Senior Partner at West St. Surgery in Chipping Norton. He died from cancer at home in February. In the months before his death he was instrumental in setting up the above, which was granted charity status in July by the Charity Commission. He thought it very important that any terminally ill patient should be able to die in their own home, if they wish, with all the help they might need.



This is a local charity which covers the patient area of West St, Whitehouse and Wychwood Surgeries, and in the few short months since the launch in early May has raised well in excess of £30,000. Events have included jumble sales, open gardens and a sponsored head shave by two brave girls, who between them raised £4,000. There have been a couple of events in Shipton recently and profits from the Harvest Lunch on September 23rd are to go to the Team. The target sum is £40,000 and it is hoped that caring for the terminally ill should be able to start in October or November.
