After a short period of re-furbishment, the new-look Second Thoughts will open for business at 9:30 a.m. on Tuesday 11th April. However, despite the fact that the name remains the same, regular customers will see a number of changes. Firstly, the shop is now completely child-focused in that the new owners will be taking and selling good-as-new children's clothes (up to aged 11 years), baby equipment, toys, books, videos and maternity wear. In keeping with the new theme, the shop aims to be one of the most child friendly in the area, with a specially designed play area for young children so that parents can shop in relative peace! The last point is especially important as the new owners plan to take their children – Alex, Harry, Felicity and Zara (plus the two latest offspring) – into work with them!

The new opening hours will be: Mondays 13:30 to 16:30 Tuesdays - Fridays 09:30 to 12:30
