TWO INCIDENTS to bring to your attention which have happened in the area.

Firstly, between 9 pm on 28th October and 9 pm on 29th October a garage was broken into at a house in Milton-under-Wychwood. The target of the thieves was a Harlev-Davidson motor cycle. The 1340 cc bike was black and yellow in colour and had an image of the Grim Reaper on the petrol tank. At the time of the theft the motorcycle was displaying the registration number T483 BWL. Possibly connected was a dark coloured saloon car containing two males. The vehicle was seen a couple of times in the small hours cruising up and down the High Street area of Milton as if looking for an address.

The second incident concerns criminal damage that has taken place in Frog Lane. During the hours of darkness garden gates have been taken off their mountings and thrown over hedges. Also, part of a low brick wall has been pushed over in what is presumed to be part of the same stupidity. No matter how persuasive the caller seems this information is of no use to any criminal investigation. Commonsense you would think but, unfortunately, many people find out the hard way.
