

Postgraduate Open Day at Oxford Brookes University

At Oxford Brookes University we recognise the skills, knowledge and expertise gained by individuals over the years in their work environments. People who have substantial, relevant and appropriate work-based experience, but who do not necessarily have a first degree, are encouraged to study for postgraduate, professional and post-experience qualifications at the University.

Our flexible postgraduate programme can be studied on either a part-time or full-time basis, with some courses available through open and distance learning.

On the Postgraduate Open Day you can visit the campus to learn more about Brookes Postgraduate Programme and talk informally with staff and students. You can find out about fees and funding and discuss your future employment prospects.

Research Degrees. The research degrees of MPhil and PhD are available in a wide range of subject areas, supervised by academics who are actively involved in research.

Professional Higher Degrees. These are designed to create strong links between research and professional practice and development and the university is creating a range of professional higher degrees.

Masters Degrees. MA, MSc, MBA and LLM degree courses contain both a taught and research element and students have to write a dissertation. Masters courses usually require one year full-time study or two years part-time and some can be studied through open or distance learning.

Postgraduate Diplomas and Certificates. These are linked to the Masters courses and usually consist of all or part of the taught element of a Masters course but do not require a dissertation.

Professional and Post-Experience Courses. These are designed to provide and enhance the skills and knowledge required within certain professions and vocational occupations. Many of these courses give candidates qualifications recognised by professional bodies.

Conversion Courses and Advanced Courses for Graduates. These courses are intended for those with existing higher education qualifications or experiential learning who wish to gain knowledge and skills in a new subject area.
