

EXHIBITION OF WILDLIFE PAINTINGS

From 19th May, for 10 days there will be an exhibition of paintings by wildlife artist Penelope Fulljames, at her studio in Milton-under-Wychwood.



This exhibition is a collection of her latest works and will include some very large landscapes of local views, plus paintings of exotic birds and animals set in wild and beautiful scenery. There will also be many small "studies" of local views, especially one of her favourite haunts – the pond at Shipton's Wild Garden.

Penelope is an internationally acclaimed artist who for the past 30 years has been working in a remote studio on the Mediterranean island of Ibiza, selling her works in London galleries and through Christie's Wildlife Art Sales, South Kensington.

Now with her newly opened studio here in the Wychwoods, she hopes to divide her time between her two studios and travelling to the wild places, deserts, forests and jungles that inspire her works.
