

## **DOOR STICKERS FOR ALL TAXIS**

West Oxfordshire District Council is issuing all taxis in the District with reflective door stickers to further identify themselves as licensed taxis. This is because of growing concerns about safety following reports of people being picked up by unlicensed vehicles.

The stickers have the vehicle registration number on them and will appear on both front doors. They are an additional form of identification to the licensed registration plate that is already at the back of each taxi. They will be much more visible to the public.

Taxi operators have been consulted during this process and many suggested using door stickers.

West Oxfordshire District Council has also placed an age restriction on licensed taxis stating they can be no more than 7 years old.

Chairman of Licensing Committee, Councillor Verena Hunt said, "These additional measures reflect the commitment of the Council towards public safety. The professionalism of taxi operators has also contributed towards introducing these changes".
