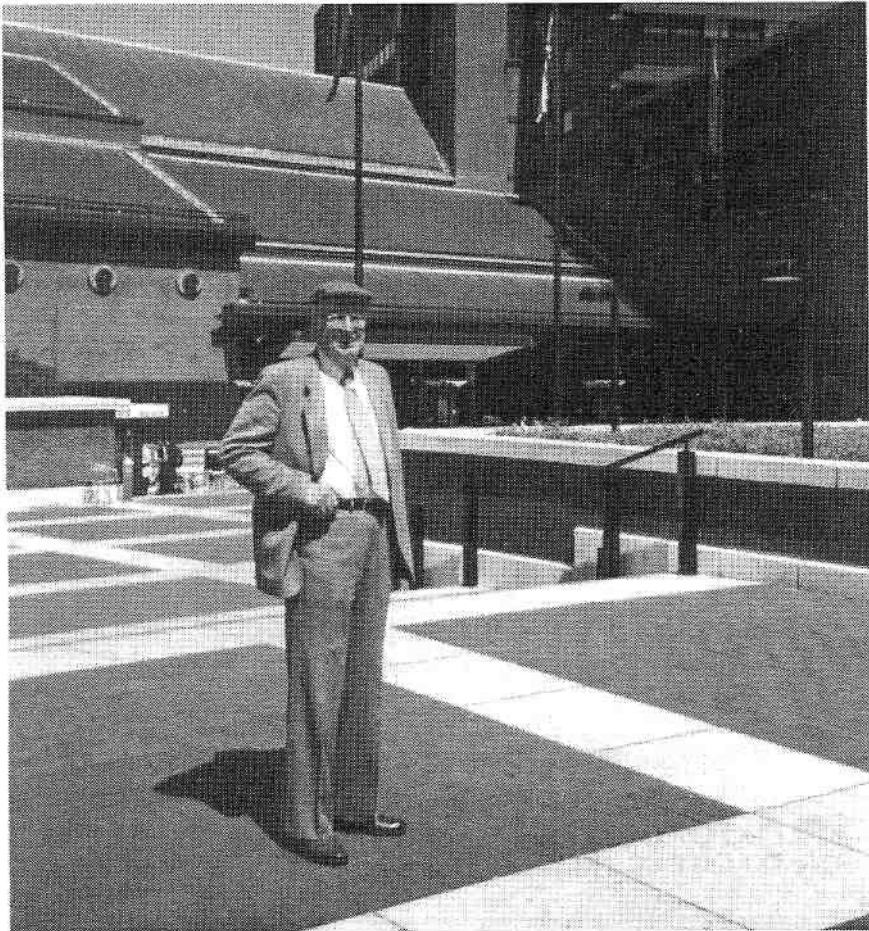
All members of the Wychwoods Local History Society were thrilled to hear that John has received a commendation for his article in Wychwoods History No.16 from the British Association of Local History.
