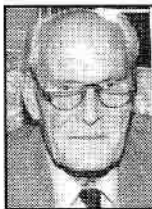

A round up of local news from the Wychwoods area

The Wychwoods Players will be performing 'O What a Lovely War' in the new year. Performances will be on the 30th and 31st of January and 1st February.

The Cotswold Art Exhibition held at Kingham School in October, raised nearly £4000 for Sargent Cancer Care for Children and Polio Plus. Over 100 artists participated including many from the Wychwoods. The event was jointly organised by the Rotary Clubs.

Enstone Art Group raised £1450 for the Lawrence Home Nursing Team in September, by auctioning 'celebrity doodles'. A sketch from Ronnie Barker, who lives in Dean, raised £500.
