when I heard my dear sibling had stooped to a life of crime; giving your fellow wolves such a bad name.

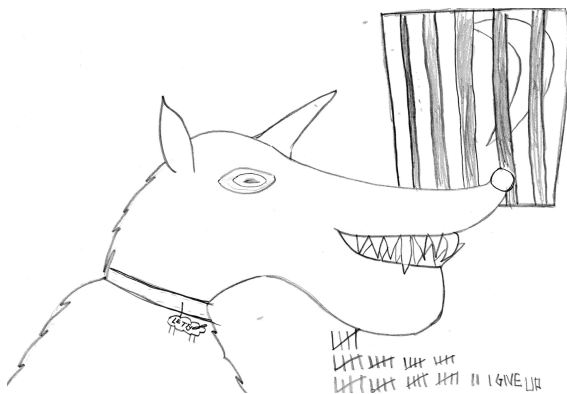
Poor deceased Great-Uncle Albert, I am certain, would not have
