Question:

When I'm using Outlook Express, how do I delete unwanted incoming mail in one go without having to delete each message separately?

Answer

One of the advantages of Windows is that the same approach will work in many different applications. To select from a list of items, click on the first item, then press and hold down the Ctrl key and click on the each item you want in the list.
