What You Can Do to Beat Those Burglars!

Darker evenings have arrived so check your home security. Use energy saving lights with timers to make your home look occupied. Dark houses stand out as a vulnerable target to burglars.

Install a motion - sensor doorstep light that warns you when someone visits in the dark. Double lock doors even when you

are at home. Remove keys from locks and put them out of sight and reach of letterboxes or cat flaps. Shut the curtains or blinds before you go out. A Burglar alarm that is visible offers good protection. Remember to set it and make sure that if accidentally triggered the alarm turns off after 20 minutes so as not to annoy neighbours.
