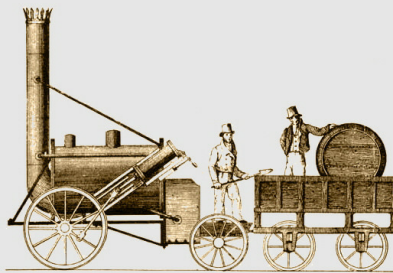
On this occasion, we salute your 'small but great' community, and we embrace Christine and Gordon, and we look forward to be back.
