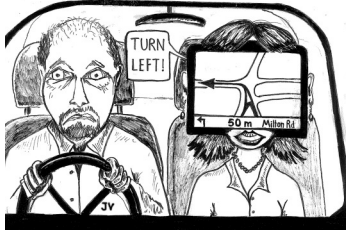


My Satnav
